As indicated in our release of the [2013-14 Final AchieveNJ Implementation Report](#) this past June, we are committed to continuous improvement of the evaluation system based on your feedback. In order to allow more time to study the implementation of AchieveNJ and associated trends over several years, the weights of each component of teacher and principal evaluation will remain the same in 2015-16 and are listed below.

<b>Student Growth Percentile (SGP)* Teacher Evaluation Weights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SGP: 10%</li> <li>• Student Growth Objective (SGO): 20%</li> <li>• Teacher Practice: 70%</li> </ul>
<b>Non-SGP Teacher Evaluation Weights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SGO: 20%</li> <li>• Teacher Practice: 80%</li> </ul>
<b>SGP* Principal/AP/VP Evaluation Weights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SGP Average: 10%</li> <li>• Administrator Goals: 30%</li> <li>• SGO Average: 10%</li> <li>• Evaluation Leadership: 20%</li> <li>• Principal Practice: 30%</li> </ul>
<b>Non-SGP Principal/AP/VP Evaluation Weights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Administrator Goals: 40%</li> <li>• SGO Average: 10%</li> <li>• Evaluation Leadership: 20%</li> <li>• Principal Practice: 30%</li> </ul>

\*SGP Teachers and Principals/APs/VPs are those who qualify for SGP scores based on the assignment of 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>-grade Language Arts and 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>-grade Math students.

We will release updated guidance materials and other evaluation resources for 2015-16 in the coming weeks.
