

Grading Types: Count Up, Count Down and Ungraded

There are 6 “count up” Grading Types:

- **Numeric** – Any numeric grade.
- **Alpha** – A configurable set of alpha grades (A+, A, A-, B+...)
- **Check marks** - ++, +, check, -, --
- **O-S-U** – Three grades: **Outstanding**, **Satisfactory** or **Unsatisfactory**
- **Pass/Fail** – Two grades: **Pass** and **Fail**.
- **Custom** – Flexible category where you specify your own grades.

There is 1 “count down” Grading Type: ‘**Pre-set Points**’. You can only use **Pre-set Points** with count down Categories.

There are 2 “ungraded” Grading Types:

- **Ungraded** – This is not graded, but it gives you a “yes”/“no” option for each student. Use it to record whether or not a student has done something (e.g. turned in a field trip form, paid for a yearbook).
- **Ungraded Text Field** – This is not graded at all but gives you the ability to capture up to 15 characters of text for each student. E.g. record a book number.
