Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope you and your families are having an enjoyable summer vacation. The staff and I are looking forward to another successful year for your children at our school. **The first day of school is Tuesday, September 6**th. Please review the information contained in this letter for the beginning of the school year.

School Hours

Kindergarten 8:30 am to 12:30 pm Grades 1 - 4 including Ms. Connallon's class 8:30 am to 2:45 pm

Traffic and Safety

Students are to use the crossing guard and crosswalk at the front of the building to cross Grove Avenue. If students are dropped off on the opposite side of Grove Avenue, parents should make sure that their child(ren) utilize the crossing guard to cross the street. We ask that parents do not make exceptions for themselves. The children model their behavior after you. If they see adults crossing anywhere, they will assume permission to do so. The time to take this procedure seriously is before an accident.

Cars should not enter the driveway (side of school) or Teacher's Parking Lot (across from school) to drop off or pick up students. Cars crossing the sidewalk in front of the school pose a serious safety risk to students.

Arrival – First Day of School

We will have an outside line up (weather permitting) on the first day of school. Kindergartners will meet their teachers outside of the library door entrance on the first day of school between 8:15 and 8:30 am. Grades 1 and 2 teachers will greet their classes outside of the main entrance (center doors) between 8:15 and 8:30 am. Grades 3 and 4 will meet their teachers outside of the auditorium entrance between 8:15 and 8:30 am. The classroom teachers will lead all students to the classrooms. Ms. Connallon's class should line up daily with their homeroom (K, 1 or 2) and Mrs. Sapienza's class should line up daily with their homeroom (grades 3 or 4) respectively as well.

Please Note:

Students will line up <u>inside</u> the building beginning on Wednesday, September 7th through the last day of school at the assigned areas (Kindergarten/Library, Grades 1 and 2/Main Office Hallway, Grades 3 and 4/Auditorium Foyer) for safety and traffic reasons. We are located on a busy county road; therefore, we have a daily indoor line up. The students will be supervised by the staff and the Principal beginning at 8:15 am each day. Please do not send your child(ren) to school before 8:15 am since supervision is not available.

Lunch

Lunch supervision (Grades 1-4 including Ms. Connallon's class and Mrs. Sapienza's class) will be provided starting the first day of school. A lunch with a drink should be brought. **No food is served during the month of September**. Pomptonian lunch, the district sponsored lunch program, will serve lunch on most days beginning in mid-October. The SCA will provide various lunches throughout the school year as well. Both lunch programs will be explained in later notices.

Snack

A healthy snack for ALL K-4 students should be brought each day beginning on the first day of school.

School Communications

On the first day of school a packet of notices will be sent home. Return requests are made on many of these notices; please try to complete and return them as requested. During the school year, notices will be sent home via hard copy every Wednesday. The school Newsletter is published on a monthly basis via email. Please take special note of our SCA board meetings held throughout the school year. The meetings are conducted in the school library at 7:00 PM and ALL parents are cordially invited. The dates have been outlined in the Joint SCA booklet. Reminder notices highlighting upcoming SCA meetings will be sent home throughout the school year.

Please Note:

Separated or divorced parents who are currently not living with their child(ren) and who desire to receive regular communication from the school should put the request in writing to the school office indicating name, current address, and telephone number. **This request should be repeated each school year.**
