The program is open to all Verona residents in grades K through 8, with the regular season running from March to early June. The month of March primarily consists of practices, with games beginning in early April. Tournament play is also offered for all 3-8 grade teams. The season is completed in early June. We welcome players of all abilities and experience to become a part of the fastest growing sport in the country!

*Family discounts are available for 3+ players/household.

Grades 5, 6, 7, and 8:

Will play on competitive teams (gender specific) and typically participate in 10 to 12 games against teams from nearby towns; practices are usually 2 or 3 times a week. Based on registration numbers, grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 will be placed into teams based on ability, experience and commitment. Select/Challenge games may be scheduled for grades 5-8. All teams will have similar game schedules with the focus on scheduling games against appropriate competition-level opponents as our teams.

Grades 5/6 Boys (\$190).....Grades 5/6 Girls (\$190) Grades 7/8 Boys (\$225).....Grades 7/8 Girls (\$215)

Grades 3 and 4: (\$165)

Separate girls and boys teams that typically play 8 to 10 modified games against teams from nearby towns, and practice about twice a week. We strive for equal playing time at the 3/4 grade level.

*** Certain teams at the 3-8 levels fill up fast so we strongly encourage you to register early to secure your roster spot and indoor winter training.

Mini Laxers: K to 2nd Grade (\$75)

Does not include winter indoor bubble sessions Children in grades K, 1, and 2, a "mini-laxer" clinic format is available. The clinic is held on Saturday afternoons for 1 hour from roughly April 14th through June 7th.
