The Verona Municipal Alliance will host "Hidden in Plain Sight" on Tuesday evening, March 31st from 7pm-8:30pm at the Verona Community Center. This educational exhibit, presented to prevent youth drug use, is suitable for parents, adult community members and any other adults working with young people. **An actual simulation of a teenager's bedroom will be on display for participants to observe, becoming familiar with where and how teens might hide drugs or paraphernalia.**

Seemingly innocent items, commonly used by youth, could actually indicate a substance abuse problem. This awareness event, presented by The Coalition for Healthy and Safe Communities, a program of The Center in Newton, will allow adults to be more proactive in helping a young person who might be using alcohol or other drugs.
