Welcome to V~SEA's 18th year!

Verona Summer Enrichment Academy's (V~SEA) goal is to expand students' knowledge base, build on their interests and encourage creative thinking. We invite your children to participate in this unique experience, where they are taught in an environment which features hands-on, materials-based learning. The program focuses on interdisciplinary investigations and activities in the areas of literacy, science and mathematics focusing on grade specific themes. Staff will construct a creative and enriching environment whereby students will enhance their skills and interests in reading, comprehending, writing and critical thinking in literature. Problem solving skills will be the focal point of the math component. Thematic science strands will be presented as a means to build the students' scientific curiosity throughout their lifetime.

Throughout our years of providing enrichment instruction, subject matter has included explorations of medieval history, Archimedes, dinosaurs, cryptology, forensics, Lego Robotics, crime scene investigation, prime and composite numbers, Aesop's Fables and much more.

The V~SEA experience welcomes children who ask questions and exhibit curiosity about the world and how it works. This form of learning only occurs in an atmosphere where imagination and daring to "think outside the box" is encouraged and valued.

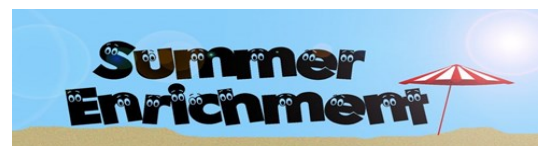
All K (students entering kindergarten in September 2023) through 5th grade students (current 4th graders/entering 5th grade in Sept. 2023) are invited to participate in the elementary program. The K, 1st and 2nd grade programs will be held at Laning Avenue School. The 3rd-5th grade programs will be held at FN Brown School.

K through 5th grade programs meet for three hours per day. K, 1 and 2 from 8:30-11:30 am (drop off begins at 8:20 am), and 3, 4 and 5 from 8:40-11:40 am (drop off begins at 8:30 am). The staggering of drop off and pick up is designed to help families with children at different sites. Fee: \$415.00. The first two children in each family pay full tuition. All additional children in that family pay a 50% reduced rate. For the K through 5 programs, parents may enroll children for up to 10 days at a reduced rate of **\$207.50**. If a child attends for 11+ days, the full tuition will be charged. If a parent chooses to enroll their child for 9 days or less, they will be obligated to pay the two-week tuition.

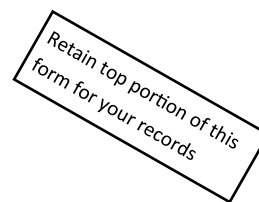
