## TASK FORCE & COMMUNITY FEEDBACK

- 150+ stakeholders represented by faculty & staff, administration, parents, and students on 12 sub-committees
- Review of 5 critical areas: Facilities, Wellness, Technology, Curriculum & Instruction, Governance & Operations
- Close examination of challenges and constraints with identified solutions
- Designed reopening plan with multiple contingencies with 2 goals in mind:
  - 1. Maintain safety of staff & students as top priority and
  - Design and implement robust teaching & learning with both in-person & remote, live stream instructional modalities

Majority of students receive remote, livestream learning and specific populations receive in-person learning

- School schedule we are accustomed to and know
- All students & staff experience in-person learning
- Health and safety of staff & students must be assured
- Return to traditional schedule when public health conditions improve

## CRITICAL CONSTRAINTS IN CREATING SCHEDULES

- Critical constraints create scheduling challenges based on CDC recommendations to ensure safety of staff & students:
  - □ Social Distancing Maintain minimum 6 feet in classrooms, hallways & common spaces. Each classroom will have maximum capacity that we can physically accommodate.
  - Masks required on school campus with limited exemptions.
  - ☐ Lunch not provided, except for free & reduced lunch

- CDC recommendation adhere to six (6) feet of social distancing in classrooms & all common spaces
- Requires reduction in total capacity in learning spaces to physically accommodate our students based on classroom & school size including transitions at HBW & VHS

#### Hybrid-B Model:

- Alternating schedule
  - Elementary AB Schedule at 50% maximum student capacity
  - Middle/High School ABCD Schedule at 25% maximum student capacity
- Specific exceptions apply, including but not limited to, preschool, self-contained special education classrooms, etc.

#### STAGE 3: HYBRID-B ELEMENTARY SCHEDULE

- Hybrid schedule serves as remote learning model & reflects grades 1-4
- Kindergarten minutes will vary. All grade level minutes based on district elementary content area guidelines for instructional minutes
- Small group and/or 1:1 instruction time slots as assigned
- Special education & related services for qualifying students throughout week
- Social Emotional Learning lessons scheduled by school counselor
- Conflict Resolution lessons taught weekly & scheduled by classroom teachers
- Brain breaks offered throughout 8:30 am 12:30 pm session
- Live streaming: students participating notified of assigned time slots for login purposes
- The daily schedule includes time for transitions

## HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

#### Class Sizes & Desk Arrangement

 Maximum number of students per classroom based upon minimum 6 feet social distancing guidelines

#### Signage

- Clearly explains required safety procedures for entry & exit of schools
- Recommended hand washing, mask requirements, 6' distancing markers

#### Hallway Flow

- One-way stairwells, two-way hallways while adhering to physical distancing
- In order to increase traffic flow, lockers will not be utilized
- Students will need to use backpacks for their materials and belongings
- Water fountains turned off & students bring individual water bottles

## DAILY SCREENING PROTOCOLS

- Parents/guardians & staff responsible for completing daily health check questionnaire form in Genesis prior to school arrival
- 2. All staff & students will be screened with temperature check prior to entering school
  - Early arrival will be necessary to start in-person school on time
- 3. Minimum requirements for #1 & #2 required otherwise entrance will not be allowed

## SYMPTOMATIC PERSON PROTOCOLS

- Students/staff exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms report to area of isolation
- Nurse evaluates COVID-19 symptoms for students/staff per guidelines
- If student symptoms confirmed, school nurse will contact parent/guardian and send home following recommended public health guidelines
- If staff member symptoms confirmed, employee sent home per public health guidelines
- If district becomes aware of an individual who is positive for COVID-19, contact tracing procedures will proceed as required under local public health department guidance

## SCHOOL & PUBLIC HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- Staff & Students
  - Appropriate mouth/nose covering required at all times on campus, with approved exceptions
  - Adhere to minimum 6 feet social distancing measures on campus
- Students
  - Attendance requirements either in-person or virtual
  - Participate in each class to ensure learning & understanding of content
  - Consistently work on assignments that are due regularly, and if there is a problem/concern, please notify the teacher or counselor immediately

#### STUDENT ATTENDANCE

- If a student will be absent, parents/guardians must notify school administrative assistant before start of school day
- Elementary teachers will take attendance when meeting with students both in-person & remote
- HBW & VHS teachers will take attendance each period when they meet with students in-person & remote
- Teachers must <u>visually</u> see students for each class to ensure that learning and understanding is occurring in each class

#### STAFF ATTENDANCE

- Staff members will follow standard sick day procedures when absent
- Substitute teacher will replace teacher absent that day
- Teachers are expected to post assignments via sub plans in Google Classroom

## ASSESSMENTS & GRADES

- Normal grading practices reinstated for the 2020-21 school using teacher designed formative (daily) & summative (unit) assessments
  - Teachers encouraged to utilize formative assessments as means to "check for learning"
  - Teachers will administer summative assessments to their students at end of our UbD units, wherever possible
  - Summative assessments may be a unit test, written paper, Google SlideShow, a structured debate, or a project.
- Regardless if the student is in person or remote, assessments will be administered
  at the same time. Assessments will be taken by students who are remote during
  the actual class meeting period time.

## FACULTY COMMUNICATION

- The communication channels will be Google Classroom, district email, and phone calls for all teachers to contact students and/or parents.
- Communication guidelines for addressing students not submitting assignments:
  - 1. The teacher will speak with the student (physically in school) or email the student directly to inquire why an assignment is missing.
  - 2. If a student doesn't respond to the teacher, or doesn't turn in assignments for **two (2)** days in a row, the teacher will email and/or call the parents.
  - 3. If after contacting the student and parents, assignments continue to remain missing, reach out to the school counselor/case manager/administration and a phone conference will occur with the parents and student.
- Staff members will make every effort to respond to emails within a 24-hour window during the work week and upon return to work with any requests over the weekend.

# BUILDING & DISTRICT COMMUNICATION

- Teachers & administrators will use Google, Remind app, phone calls, and emails to communicate with families
- E-blast communications will be sent via Constant Contact
- Updates will be posted on our district website. The link is included here: <u>Covid-19 Updates</u>

## ATHLETICS

- NJSIAA guidance allows for a safe return to play pending evolving nature of public health concerns
- NJSIAA established COVID-19 Medical Advisory Task Force & Sports Advisory Task Force to review State & Local Health guidelines, as well as NJDOE guidance, to determine changes that will need to be made to accommodate the 2020-21 interscholastic sports seasons
- The Verona Public Schools District reserves the right under local control to cancel seasonal
  athletics activities when deemed necessary in the best interest of health and safety of our
  student athletes, coaches, & volunteers, as well as coordination of operational and financial
  constraints
- Students who opt for remote learning option only may participate in interscholastic athletics
- Athletics will be played outside or in larger spaces to allow for social distancing, whenever possible
- Please visit the <u>NJSIAA website</u> to utilize their COVID-19 resources as it pertains to interscholastic athletics

# EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES & USE OF FACILITIES

- Extra Curricular appointments will be approved on an as needed basis. If approved, activities will:
  - adhere to the same social distancing and hygiene protocols setup for the classrooms
  - be held virtually, whenever possible
- Community organization facility utilization, including recreation programs, will be highly restricted
  - If approved by the District, social distancing & public health protocols are required
- All meetings & clubs will be held virtually, whenever possible
- Until further notice, all in-person field trips will not be permitted

## **FACILITIES**

- Increased, routine cleaning & disinfection of touch point surfaces as outlined in district policy
- Includes, but is not limited to, cleaning objects & surfaces such as doorknobs, light switches, sink handles, and countertops
- Classroom desks, chairs, and tables will be wiped down regularly between classes
- Limit number of people in bathrooms at one time and maintain 6' social distancing
- Water fountains will be disabled in all buildings while students/staff will be encouraged to bring in individual water bottles
- Hand sanitizer will be made available at the entrance of each building, each classroom, and designated hallway locations
- Doors and windows remain open for increased ventilation
- Replacement of HEPA filters with highest rating of MERV-13
- Purchase and installation of air purifiers in designated locations
- Plastic barriers installed in office and common areas

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION & HEALTH

- Designed to develop motor skills, knowledge, & behaviors for physical activity
   & fitness
- Locker Rooms will remain closed per public health guidelines. Students will wear comfortable clothing & athletic footwear to school, allowing for safe movement
- Physical education lessons will involve minimal physical education equipment
- When possible, teachers will use outdoor spaces for physical education instruction
- If using the gymnasium or multipurpose room for instruction, doors & windows
  will remain open if possible, to maximize circulation and air flow to
  accommodate for increased respiration by students while participating in
  physical activity

# SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL & ACADEMIC SUPPORTS

### **ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS**

- Comprehensive approach to addressing academic, behavioral & socialemotional needs of students with interventions both inside & outside of school
- Elementary counselors will continue with Peekapak

## FOOD SERVICE

- Students viewing remotely from home will be able to watch live teacher lessons and engage in learning as per school developed daily class schedule
