Give Students "Class Ids" for this Class

A "Class Id" is an id number you can use just for your class – E.g. you can print "anonymous" assignment scores listed by the Gradebook Id.

- 1. Edit the students' "Gradebook Id" fields. You can either:
 - a. Pick numbers your self
 - b. Use the Starting ID Number: field at the upper right of the screen. Enter the starting Id number for the class and click
- 2. Click "Save" to save the changes.

To randomize the Gradebook Ids, do the following:

- On the Gradebook→Gradebook screen, click the "Id" column header.
 This sorts the students by their District Student Id that is, it sorts them more or less randomly.
- Then, click on the <u>Active Students</u> label to bring up the Class Roster screen.
- 3. Now, generate Id numbers using the "Starting Ids Number" field at the upper right of the screen. Enter the starting Id number for the class and click "Go"
- 3. Click "Save" to save the changes.
