## Drop-Off & Pick-Up Safety is Our Priority!

- No child should arrive to school before 8:15AM. This is the time at which staff is available to supervise students.
- All K-4 students should enter the building by way of Lanning Road, not Elk Rd. The Elk Road entrance is for pre-school children only.
- When possible, walk to school. This will reduce the number of vehicles in front of our school each morning. If you can't walk please consider carpooling.
- When dropping off students in the morning, please proceed as far forward as possible in your vehicle.
   This enables more vehicles to fall into line. Children will enter the building at the canopy entrance.
   Teachers will be in the hallway at 8:15AM to direct children to their classrooms.
- No parking, for any length of time, in spots designated no parking in front of our school.
- Please have students prepared at home so they may exit cars (curbside) in a timely fashion. Remember, sometimes up to 125 vehicles drop off children within a ten minute span. We need to make space for these vehicles.
- Having students walk in between cars during pick up or drop off in the middle of Lanning Road is an
  unacceptable and dangerous practice.
- If you would like to "see" your child walk in the building, you must park legally and walk your child to the nearest entrance. No parking, for any length of time, in the drop off zone.
- All crossing of Lanning Road should only occur at the corner of Elmwood Rd or Otsego Rd.
- No vehicles should be entering or leaving the school parking lot on Lanning Road at pick-up or drop-off times.

#### -School Initiatives-Elementary Math Curriculum Review Team

- The team will continue to discuss, visit, and review elementary mathematics programs that will enrich student learning and teacher pedagogy and in turn will lead to a re-designed math curriculum and approach in Verona's elementary schools.





## -School Initiatives-Conflict Resolution/Peer Mediation

- The Peer Mediation program began mid-year during the 17-18 school year. It will now be fully implemented during the current school year.

#### **Detective Joel Martin**

- \*Parking for drop off or pick up at painted yellow curbs is strictly prohibited. Annually, problems arise with vehicles parking to close to intersections surrounding the schools. New Jersey State Law prohibits parking within an intersection, crosswalk or obstructing a private driveway.
- \*Parents and students should ALWAYS use our crossing guards and crosswalks to cross Lanning Road or surrounding streets. Not only are you setting a proper example for students, New Jersey State Law prohibits crossing any roadway at any place other than a marked crosswalk.
- \*If you need to visit the school, please park in designated visitor parking only or on the South side of Lanning Road. Faculty parking areas are designated for faculty whom arrive throughout the school day. Complying with these regulations allows for access by emergency vehicles, if necessary.
- \*The area immediately in front of the school on Lanning Road is a designated drop off zone.

  Please do not exit your vehicle to assist children from your car, this delays and impedes the flow of morning drop off.
