

Math Classes

Algebra 1 Readiness: (For current 6th, 7th and 8th graders who will be taking Algebra 1 in September) Algebra 1 is the foundation of all high school mathematics classes. The main goal of Algebra 1 is to develop fluency in working with linear equations. The Algebra 1 Readiness Course is designed to assist students in mastering target standards with a primary focus on developing students' mastery of arithmetic concepts and skills. Through the topics presented in this course, students will solidify understandings introduced in Pre-Algebra and will be better prepared to tackle new topics that will be learned in Algebra 1. Topics that will be covered include integers and their operations, rational numbers, simplifying expressions, solving equations and inequalities, functions, graphing in the coordinate plane, writing and graphing linear equations, and solving systems of linear equations. The Algebra 1 Readiness class will meet for 1 1/2 hours per day from 8:30-10:00 am. Fee: \$192.50

Fundamentals of Pre-Algebra: (For current 6th and 7th graders who will be in on-level math in September): Are you bored with Math and really do not want to take a Math class during the summer? Well, this isn't your typical Math class. You will still explore integers rational numbers, simplifying expressions, solving inequalities, functions and graphing. But you will learn to apply these concepts to your own life. For instance, you will learn how coordinate plane graphing is used in movie, animation, and video game making or how inequalities can be used to make smarter, wiser decisions in life. While learning how to apply these concepts to your everyday life, you will also build a foundation to take your math skills to the next level. The Fundamentals of Pre-Algebra class will meet for 1 1/2 hours per day form 10:00-11:30 am. Fee. : \$192.50
