Once an old swamp, the lake was first formed in 1814 when Doctor Gone (or Bohn) dammed the Peckman River for a grist mill! The Verona Environmental Commission teamed up with the Verona Park Conservancy to clean the lake.

Please join us! We'll meet at the south end at 9am, near the entrance on Park Avenue and Hathaway Lane.

All ages and abilities welcomed. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult. Essex County Park waivers must be signed at the event, also available at veronaec.org. The Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission donated gloves and trash bags. We'll have grabber tools, long handled nets and a rowboat. Please bring your own water, and a net with handle or leaf rakes if you have them, to help remove litter from the shore line. Thank you!
