2018-2019 School Year

As you know, it is much easier for a student to be successful when they are organized. Organization is a learned skill that requires consistency and diligence.

FOR ALL OLMSTED HOMEROOMS:

- ☐ Two boxes of tissues from each student to be stored for classroom use (Much appreciated - we run out every year)
- ☐ Classrooms donations of the following items: hand sanitizers, paper towels, baby wipes, and clorox wipes.

*If your child's homeroom is in Room 101 or 104, he or she will have a **SMALL** locker that is located in the classroom. Therefore, **one TALL (12 inches high) locker shelf** (wire variety) is a huge help for organizing and fitting all materials.*

DAILY SUPPLIES *(to be used in all classes):*

We will be distributing **assignment pads** (daily planners) on the first day of school. These should be brought to every class and will be used every day. There is no need to buy a pad for homework.

- ☐ sharpened pencils (always replenish when needed)
- ☐ colored pencils
- ☐ two highlighters (various colors)
- ☐ pens (red, blue and black)
- ☐ scissors
- ☐ glue sticks
- ☐ pencil case for the supplies listed above
- ☐ skinny markers
- ☐ handheld pencil sharpener
- ☐ Ruler with mm/cm markings (**keep at home**)

- ☐ erasers (*optional*)
- ☐ whiteout tape (*optional*) ****no liquid please!**

SUPPLIES FOR INDIVIDUAL SUBJECTS:

When students grab their books and supplies for their next class (or two), it can be helpful to have different subjects color-coded. That is why there is a suggested color-coding system beside each subject.

Mrs. Halbert's Literacy Classes:

* Suggested Color-Coding: **Yellow**

- ☐ One 2-inch binder with **4 dividers** (labeled: Grammar/Conventions, Literature/Reading, Vocabulary, Writing)
- ☐ **1 folder** (with holes)
- ☐ Fill each section of binder with plenty of lined paper
- ☐ Post it notes 3x3 size (**You will need these everyday in class**)
- ☐ 3x5 index cards with a **soft** index card holder (**Labeled Literacy and your name**)
- ☐ Silent reading material (brought to class daily for silent reading time)
- ☐ Two large plastic Ziploc bags (preferably 2 gallon size) Labeled: Name and Book Bag

Mrs. Sarett's Math Classes:

* Suggested Color-Coding: **Red**

- ☐ **Two 5-subject Notebook** and **1 folder** (unless the notebook has a strong pocket inside)
- ☐ 4-function Basic **Calculator**
- ☐ A package of **Whiteboard Markers**
- ☐ One **XL Book Sock** or cover for textbook

Mrs. Albano's Science Classes:

* Suggested Color-Coding: **Green**

- ☐ **One 1 ½ inch Three Ring Binder** with **4 dividers** and **1 folder** (with holes)
- ☐ **One** pack of **Loose-leaf Paper**
- ☐ **About 20 sheets of Graph Paper**
- ☐ **Two** packs of 3x5 index cards with a **soft** index card holder (**Labeled Science and your name**)

Mrs. Catalano's Social Studies Classes:

* Suggested Color-Coding: **Blue**

- ☐ **One 1 ½ - 2 inch binder** with **4 dividers** (labeled Do Nows, Notes, Homework/Classwork, Vocabulary) and **1 folder** (with holes)
- ☐ **One** pack of **Loose-leaf Paper**
- ☐ Post-it notes

Mr. Palazzo's Math Resource Room:

* Suggested Color-Coding: **Red**

- ☐ **One** 3-subject notebook labeled Math and **1 folder** (with holes)
- ☐ 4-function Basic **Calculator**
- ☐ A package of **Whiteboard Markers**
- ☐ **Two** packs of 3x5 index cards with a **soft** index card holder. (**Labeled Math and your name**)

Also, please be mindful that trapper-keepers should **not** replace binders as they are pricey and do **not** fit in the lockers here at H.B. Whitehorne.
