We are happy to extend a warm welcome to the Verona Public Schools' kindergarten program for your child. Kindergarten is an essential milestone in your child's educational journey, and we are excited to be a part of this important chapter.

Our kindergarten program is designed to provide a solid foundation for your child's academic and social development. During the school day, we offer a comprehensive curriculum that includes media skills, formal art, music, and physical education. It's a time for learning and forming new friendships, working collaboratively in groups, and acquiring fundamental academic skills.

Important Information:

- Children must be 5 years of age on or before Oct. 1, 2025, to enroll
- Kindergarten session hours: 8:30 am to 2:45 pm.

Kindergarten Round-Up: January 13-17, 2025

This week, we will identify eligible students for the upcoming September class and initiate a formal registration. Please download the enrollment packet and review the required [registration documents](#). Complete these forms during Round-Up week and submit them to the school office.

Required Documents:

- Original birth certificate with a raised seal (original will be returned to you).
- Proof of residency (see below).
- Parent/guardian proof of identity (driver's license or passport).
- All health forms must be completed by May 31st, 2025.

A physical exam is mandatory for all first-time Verona Public Schools students. The Universal Child Health Record (in the downloaded forms) and a copy of the most recent immunizations must be submitted to the school nurse. Physical exams conducted by a healthcare provider between **September 2, 2024, and September 2, 2025**, will be accepted.

Parents of children attending the Verona Preschool Program should register their children in their neighborhood school and complete the screening process there. If their child receives special education services, their information will be forwarded to the appropriate school according to their Individualized Education Program (IEP).

Early registration is crucial for effective planning. To balance class sizes across the district, parents may request to send their child to one of the three other elementary schools. If this applies to you, please submit a written request to the Office of the Superintendent. Decisions regarding these requests will be made in May 2025, but written requests should be made as soon as possible. ***Per Board Policy 5120 Assignment of Students, students who enroll after February 1, 2025, are subject to placement in a school with space if the neighborhood school class size prohibits adding more students.***
